

» A Union of Skills to equip people for a competitive Europe (source: European Commission)

Europe is facing a skills and labour gap. To overcome this, Europe needs a radical step change in ambition and action. Delivering on the commitment in its <u>Political Guidelines</u>, as well as the <u>Draghi</u> <u>Report</u>, the European Commission has presented the <u>Union of Skills</u>. By bridging the gap between labour supply and demand by identifying skills shortages across European countries, a Union of Skills will support this Commission's work; from <u>boosting competitiveness</u> to ensuring the transition to a <u>clean economy</u>. <u>Research projects</u> funded under Horizon Europe are contributing to this initiative by proposing holistic approaches to skills development, with a focus on ensuring Europe's social model is protected.

European Partnership for Radiation Protection Research

<u>PIANOFORTE</u> is launching the third transnational Open Call for Proposals to support innovative research projects in radioprotection. The aims of the call are:

- To support transnational research projects that combine innovative approaches in the field of radiation protection in line with the research priorities of PIANOFORTE;
- To actively integrate Education&Training activities and collaboration with universities in multidisciplinary research projects;
- To make optimal use of research infrastructures.

The 3 main research topics this year are:

- Topic 1: Investigating the effects of temporal and spatial variations in dose delivery on the risk of health effects.
- Topic 2: Developing an integrated approach for risk assessment and evaluation from environmental exposure to ionizing radiation.
- Topic 3: Use of Artificial Intelligence and Big Data techniques to improve emergency response covering radiological impact assessments, decision support, data collection response and recovery strategies and public engagement, communication and education.
