## 2. POLICY NEWS

» **RM Comp**: The European Competence Framework for Research Managers (source: CARDEA and RM ROADMAP)

Tool to assess and develop research managers' transferable skills and foster career development, developed by two projects funded by the European Union, [CARDEA](#) and [RM ROADMAP](#), in close consultation with the European Commission and relevant stakeholders.

» Poland's EU presidency: **Security at the top of the agenda** (source: EU Parliament)

Presenting Poland's priorities, Prime Minister Donald Tusk underlined security as a key priority for Europe as war still rages on its borders, the US goes through political change and disinformation online poses new challenges. He stressed that spending up to 5% of GDP on security and defence is necessary, and warned Europe needs to arm itself to survive:

"Do not ask America what they can do for our security, ask yourselves what we can do for our security."

A majority of MEPs supported the Polish presidency's call to prioritize security. They highlighted the need for increased military spending, the development of a strong defence industry, and enhanced cooperation with NATO and other non-EU countries.

Many MEPs pushed for continuing the EU's efforts to reduce its reliance on Russian energy sources while ensuring citizens have access to affordable energy.

» [CESAER](#) President [Orla Feely](#) shared some **key considerations for FP10** in the European Parliament (source: CESAER)

1. FP10 must **simplify radically** and act decisively by taking bold steps and **embracing risk to drive innovation**, while not forgetting about the importance of **fundamental research**.
2. FP10 should focus on attracting and retaining talent by focusing on **retaining early-career researchers and attracting key senior experts**, leveraging MSCA and ERC as beacons of excellence. Attracting and retaining R&I talent for Europe will be crucial to ensure that our ecosystem changes into becoming more innovation-driven.
3. [Industry-university collaboration is key for a successful FP10 and we need more of it](#). We must integrate skills and talent development across all programs, exploring diverse models like industrial PhDs.

» The **New European Bauhaus (NEB)** receives a **€120M budget and its own dedicated work programme** (source: Science Business)

This initiative, combining sustainability, innovation, and art, is now a standalone funding facility under Horizon Europe. With its increased budget, the EU built environment initiative aims to allocate more resources for research and drive projects that support the EUGreenDeal by promoting sustainable and inclusive design.

💡 Highlights:

- Focus on green innovation and cultural transformation
- Strengthening links between science, creativity, and sustainability
- Supporting projects aligned with climate neutrality goals

» **An EU Competitiveness Compass to regain competitiveness and secure sustainable prosperity** (source: European Commission)

The European Commission has presented the [Competitiveness Compass](#), the first major initiative of this mandate providing a strategic and clear framework to steer the Commission's work. The Compass sets a path for Europe to become the place where future technologies, services, and clean products are invented, manufactured, and put on the market, while being the first continent to become climate neutral. (source: European Commission)

It is [composed by](#) 3 transformation imperatives:

- Bridging the innovation gap,
- Joint roadmap for decarbonization and competitiveness, and
- Increase economic security and reduce dependencies

And five horizontal factors necessary to support competitiveness in all sectors:

- Simplification
- Elimination of obstacles to the Single Market
- Funding
- Competences and quality jobs and,
- Better coordination

### 3. FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES & UPCOMING CALLS

#### » **Cascade Funding Calls / Financial Support for Third Parties (FSTP)**

Cascade funding is a mechanism that organizes the distribution of funds into several stages or levels. In the Horizon Europe context, funds are channeled through a main entity that manages the funding and are then distributed to final beneficiaries through specific calls for proposals:

- \* allows project beneficiaries to award grants to third-party recipients i.e. entities or persons that are not partners in the consortium.

- \* starts from an ongoing project on which these beneficiaries can be added during the course of the project.

#### » **EIT RawMaterials - Call for RIS Projects (Capacity Building and Innovation)**

Call 2025 | Deadline: 28th February 2025

EIT RawMaterials has launched a new call for innovation projects that promote sustainable solutions in the raw materials value chain. Submissions are open until February 28th, with several cut-off dates throughout the year, allowing greater flexibility for candidates.

The program is aimed at startups, SMEs, researchers and academic institutions eligible for funding under Horizon Europe. Participants will benefit from access to strategic mentoring, funding networks and international collaboration opportunities. Projects should focus on areas such as responsible sourcing, development of sustainable materials and promotion of circular economies, aligned with the objectives of carbon neutrality and environmental sustainability.

Call 2025 | Deadline: 27th March 2025

Long-Term Joint EU-AU Research and Innovation Partnership on Sustainable Energy (LEAP-SE) program co-funded by the European Commission (EC) under Horizon Europe aims at developing a long-term **partnership between Europe and Africa on Research and Innovation (R&I) on sustainable energy.**

The range of activities recommended for collaboration under LEAP-SE will focus on 7 identified multi-annual roadmaps presented in the Call and also on the LEAP-RE thematic priorities:

- Assessment of Renewable Energy Sources and integration of RES in sustainable energy scenarios;
- End-of-life and second-life management and environmental impact of RE components;
- Smart stand-alone systems;
- Smart grid (different scales) for off grid application;
- Processes and appliances for productive uses (agriculture, mobility and industry);
- Innovative solutions for priority domestic uses (clean cooking and cold chain);
- Production and utilization of Green Hydrogen.

The LEAP-SE Joint Call 2025 will **fund basic research, applied research and experimental development projects** that are 12-36 months long. However, applicants should be aware that each funding agency participating to the Call will apply its own rules and regulations regarding eligibility and criteria (nationality, thematic, nature of project, TRL, rate of subsidy, etc.).

» **Clean Hydro-gen Partnership**

Call 2025 | Deadline: 23 April 2025

With a total budget of €184.5 million, the Clean Hydrogen 2025 call aims to accelerate innovation across critical areas of the hydrogen value chain and reflects the continued commitment towards advancing clean hydrogen technologies for climate neutrality and competitiveness in Europe.
