» **European Partnership on Virtual Worlds** (source: LinkedIn)

A pivotal workshop on: “National Initiatives and the European Partnership on Virtual Worlds” was organized with over 90 participants from across Europe gathered to align efforts and shape a shared vision for Virtual Worlds.

Key takeaways:

- The European Commission introduced the Partnership
- Siemens leads private coordination, supported by top EU institutions
- Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) will drive €150M in funding calls starting 2026
- The future of Virtual Worlds goes beyond XR – AI, simulation, digital twins, and intuitive interfaces.

Key pillars of the new strategy include:

- Building a strong ecosystem of research and technology infrastructures, with targeted capacity building and strategic investments across Member States and regions.
- Facilitating access, especially for startups and scaleups, to ensure that innovation can scale from lab to market with fewer barriers.
- Developing a common governance framework to improve coordination, efficiency, and long-term sustainability of infrastructure initiatives.
- Enhancing international cooperation, to ensure Europe remains a global leader in open science, cutting-edge research, and technological development.

Boosting talent attraction and retention through the Choose Europe initiative, making Europe a top destination for researchers, innovators, and entrepreneurs from around the world.

This strategic direction is crucial to delivering on the EU's green and digital transitions, boosting competitiveness, and reinforcing resilience.

» **Expert Group for Partnerships and EU Missions** (source: ERALEARN)

Under the European Union's Framework Programme for Research and Innovation, major directional initiatives - such as **European Partnerships** and **EU Missions** - play a crucial role in addressing complex and urgent challenges.

The European Commission aims to establish a **dedicated expert group** to develop and test a robust methodology to guide the identification, design and selection of these directional initiatives under the next Framework Programme (**FP10**).

» Portugal participates in the Eureka Network call on **Applied Quantum Technologies**

Call deadline: 5th September 2025

This [initiative](#) is promoted by Eureka Network, and will support international collaborative projects in the applied quantum technologies area. Another 10 countries participate, including Portugal, Áustria, Bélgica (Flandres and Valónia), Dinamarca, Finlândia, França, Espanha, África do Sul, Turquia and Ucrânia.

Proposals should be submitted by consortia of, at least two organizations, from the participating countries. The team should be led by a commercial company (main applicant) in the respective countries and may include other parties such as research institutes or universities. There will be a *webinar* on the 27th of May, where ANI will present the national funding conditions.
