Last week's **Horizon Europe Writing Collaborative Projects Training** was a major success, despite the challenges of integrating **new online and AI modules**. The event was made possible thanks to the strong support from **Research Managers** and organizers, with special recognition to Sofia Martins, Rute Martins, Evelyne Rodrigues, Clara Pereira, Dina Davide, and Sandra Justo. The training drew **46 registrants**, with an average of **24 participants per module**, and the **AI module saw the highest attendance**. Participants came with diverse experience levels, including **expert evaluators** and insights from **TU Berlin**, contributing to rich, practical discussions. Early feedback highlights the training's **hands-on, strategy-focused approach**, setting it apart from existing generic offerings.

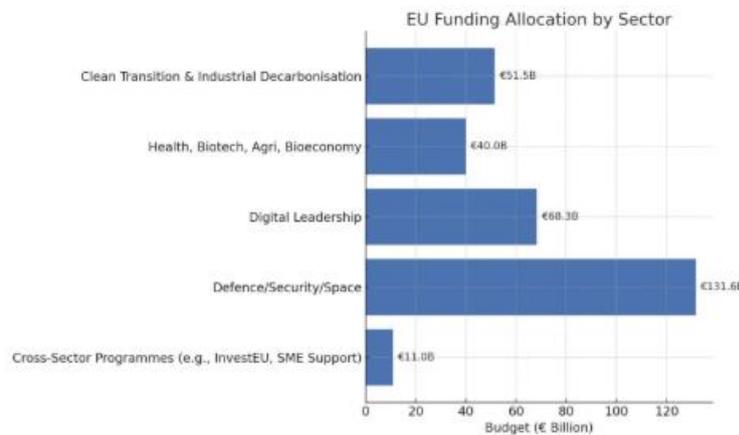
2. POLICY NEWS

» **Summary of the key points** from the proposed next phase of the **Horizon Europe** programme (2028–2034), based on the European Commission’s July 16 proposal (source: Science Business)

Pillar	Current Budget	Proposed Budget	Key Change
Frontier Research (P1)	€25B	€44B	Boost for ERC & MSCA
Collaborative (P2)	€53.5B	€75.8B	Managed partly by ECF; split into "competitiveness" and "society"
Innovation (P3)	€13.6B	€38.7B	Major increase for the EIC
Research Policy (P4)	€3.4B	€16.2B	Includes Widening and infrastructures

Overall Budget & Structure:

- **Total Horizon Europe budget:** Proposed to increase to **€175 billion** (nearly double the current amount).
- **Major Change:** €68 billion from collaborative research (Pillar 2) will be managed by a new **European Competitiveness Fund**.
- **ECF Total Budget:** €410 billion (includes €175B for Horizon Europe and €234B for other schemes).



European Competitiveness Fund (ECF)

- A new umbrella fund with **€410B total**: €175B from Horizon Europe (Pillar 2). €234B from other EU schemes.

» Horizon Europe to Back Dual-Use R&D by Default (source: Science Business)

The EU will drop its civilian-only funding rule in Horizon Europe, enabling **dual-use (civil/defence)** projects across all pillars—not just the EIC. Commissioner **Zaharieva** confirmed the shift, aligning the programme more closely with **strategic priorities** like defence, security, and space. (background documents: [Dual-use technologies](#); [Unlocking the potential of dual-use research and innovation](#); [Making the most of EU Research and Innovation Investments: rethinking dual use](#); [White Paper for European Defence – Readiness 2030](#); [European Preparedness Union Strategy](#); [European Internal Security Strategy – ProtectEU](#); [White Paper on options for enhancing support for research and development involving technologies with dual-use potential](#); [public consultation](#))

Despite this, **bottom-up research** via the **European Research Council** will remain protected. The **€175B proposal** nearly doubles the current budget, aiming to close the funding gap for high-quality projects. Member states support the ambition but await clarity on **budget allocation** and ECF coordination.

» [South Korea](#) has officially joined Horizon Europe (source: European Commission)

Through this agreement, **Korea is now associated with Pillar II**, which focuses on global challenges and industrial competitiveness. Korean researchers and organisations can now participate in collaborative projects alongside EU partners on equal footing. This **strengthens EU–Korea cooperation** in areas like **climate, energy, digital tech, and global health**.

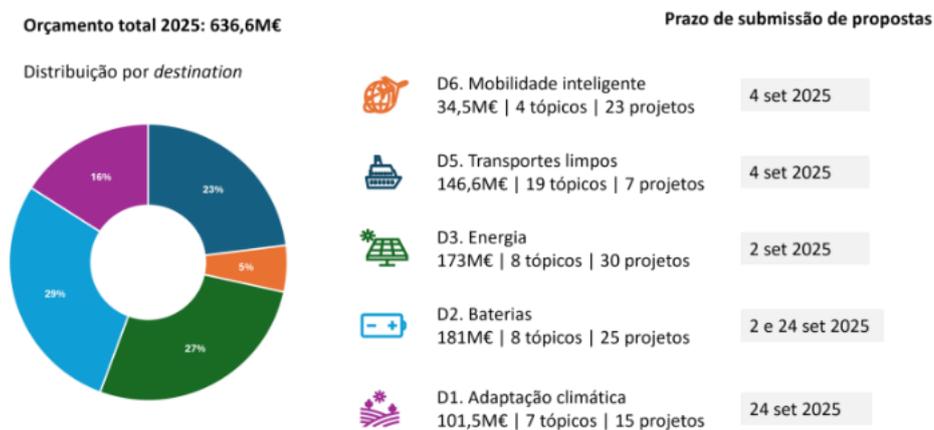

» [New ERC Workshop Report: Unlocking Innovation Through Frontier Research](#) (source: Maria Leptin, ERC President) #report

Why is Europe lagging in disruptive innovation and economic growth—and what can be done about it? Leading scientists, industry experts in critical technologies, and policymakers identified key structural barriers holding back innovation in Europe, including: a) Market and regulatory **fragmentation** across Member States; b) Lack of a **true financial union** and unified standards; c) **Duplication of efforts** and inconsistent implementation of EU legislation; d) **Underfunding** of high-risk, frontier research and e) A **risk-averse regulatory culture**

The message was clear: Tackling these challenges requires **long-term, risk-tolerant support for fundamental science**, beyond short-term cycles or narrow industrial targets.

» **Key Updates in the [ERC Work Programme 2026](#)**

1. **Streamlined Structure:** updated and simplified, with revised sections on **proposal submission** and **evaluation criteria**.
2. **Proposal Format Changes:** The **Scientific Proposal** is now split into **Part I** (background, objectives, and strategy) and **Part II** (implementation). Evaluation elements have been adjusted accordingly.
3. **Eligibility Extensions:** New eligibility extensions are available for **Starting and Consolidator Grant** applicants who have experienced **gender-based or other violence**. **Parental leave** has also been formally added to extension grounds.
4. **Resubmission Restriction:** **Synergy Grant** applicants who received a **'B' score in Step 1 of the 2025 call** are barred from reapplying in 2026.
5. **Increased Incentives for International Talent:** The **additional funding cap** has been **doubled** for **Starting, Consolidator, and Advanced Grant** applicants relocating from non-associated third countries to the EU or an associated country.
