ERC STARTING GRANT (StG) CHECKLIST

General Requirements

- For **PIs starting or recently started** their independent research
- Project must be led by one or more **Principal Investigators (PIs)**
- PI(s) must demonstrate the **ground-breaking nature and ambition** of the proposed research
- PIs are **scientifically responsible** for the project

Eligibility & Objectives

- Check **PI PhD date** is between 1 Jan 2019 and 31 Dec 2023
- Verify **at least one key publication without PhD supervisor**
- Must show **potential for independence and leadership**, e.g., key publications as main author

Funding & Duration

- Set project duration (**up to 60 months**)
- Define budget **up to €1.5M**
- Justify additional funding request (up to €1M)
- Ensure budget complies with **actual-cost model + 25% indirect cost**

Time Commitment

- Ensure PI commits **at least 50% working time to the project**
- Ensure PI spends **at least 50% of working time in EU/Associated Country**

Evaluation & Proposal

- Prepare Part I: research idea, objectives, state-of-the-art (max 5 pages)
- Prepare Part II: methodology, risk assessment, resources (max 7 pages)
- Draft CV and Track Record (max 4 pages)
- Include **Host Institution Support Letter**: ask for it to dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt

- send the budget for checking **financial viability** to:
dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt, **two weeks in advance of the deadline**
- Submit proposal electronically before **deadline: 14th October 2025**

ERC SYNERGY GRANT (SyG) CHECKLIST

General Requirements

- Form **group of 2 to 4 Principal Investigators**
- Synergy Grant applicants must show that the group can **combine complementary expertise** to tackle complex problems
- PI(s) must demonstrate the **ground-breaking nature and ambition** of the proposed research
- PIs are **scientifically responsible** for the project
- PIs of **any seniority level** may apply, with a **competitive track record**
- One PI (excluding the Corresponding PI) **may be based outside the EU or Associated Country**

Eligibility & Objectives

- Assign **one Corresponding PI**
- Ensure **research challenge cannot be addressed by a single PI**
- Confirm one PI may be hosted outside the EU/Associated Country (except Corresponding PI)

Funding & Duration

- Set project duration (**up to 72 months**)
- Define budget **up to €10M**
- Justify **additional funding request (up to €4M)**
- Use **actual-cost model + 25% indirect cost**

Time Commitment

- Ensure each PI commits **at least 30% working time to project**
- Ensure each EU/AC-hosted PI spends **at least 50% working time in EU/Associated Country**

Evaluation & Proposal

- Prepare Part I (max 5 pages) and Part II (max 10 pages)
- Provide CV and Track Record (4 pages per PI)
- Include detailed collaboration and resource plan
- Submit Host Institution Support Letters for all participating institutions; ask for the commitment letter to dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt
- send the budget for checking **financial viability** to: dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt, **one week in advance of the deadline**
- If invited to the interview, contact your research manager and DPFC at pre-award@ist-id.pt

ERC CONSOLIDATOR GRANT (CoG) CHECKLIST

General Requirements

- For PIs **consolidating** their independent research programme
- Project must be led by one or more **Principal Investigators (PIs)**
- PI(s) must demonstrate the **ground-breaking nature and ambition** of the proposed research
- PIs are **scientifically responsible** for the project

Eligibility & Objectives

- Check **PI PhD date** is between 1 Jan 2014 and 31 Dec 2018
- Must show clear **evidence of research independence**

Funding & Duration

- Set project duration (**up to 60 months**)
- Define budget **up to €2M**
- Justify **additional funding request (up to €1M)**

- Use **actual-cost model + 25% indirect cost**

Time Commitment

- Ensure PI commits **at least 40% working time to the project**
- Ensure PI spends **at least 50% of working time in EU/Associated Country**

Evaluation & Proposal

- Prepare **Part I and II** of the scientific proposal
- Complete **CV and Track Record**
- Include **budget and resources breakdown**
- Provide Host Institution Support Letter: ask for it to dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt
- send the budget for checking **financial viability** to: dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt, **two weeks in advance of the deadline**
- If invited to the interview, contact your research manager and DPFC at pre-award@ist-id.pt

ERC ADVANCED GRANT (AdG) CHECKLIST

General Requirements

- For **established research leaders**
- Project must be led by one or more **Principal Investigators (PIs)**
- PI(s) must demonstrate the **ground-breaking nature and ambition** of the proposed research
- PI must be **active in research**
- PIs are **scientifically responsible** for the project
- Must have a **track record of significant research achievements**

Eligibility & Objectives

- Confirm PI is an **active researcher with significant achievements**
- Validate **international recognition and leadership**

Funding & Duration

- Set project duration (**up to 60 months**)
- Define budget **up to €2.5M**
- Justify **additional funding (up to €1M)**
- Use **lump sum model**

Time Commitment

- Ensure PI commits **at least 30% working time to the project**
- Ensure PI spends **at least 50% working time in EU/Associated Country**

Evaluation & Proposal

- Prepare **Part I and II** of scientific proposal
- Provide **CV and Track Record**
- Submit **Equipment Depreciation Table**
- Include **budget justification**
- Provide Host Institution Support Letter: ask for it to dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt
- send the budget for checking **financial viability** to: dprojetos@tecnico.ulisboa.pt, **one week in advance of the deadline**
- If invited to the interview, contact your research manager and DPFC at pre-award@ist-id.pt
