## **Fellowships for PhD students**

Applications are open for 1 Fellowship(s) for PhD candidate, within the framework of the project eGamesLab n26 of IST-ID, CC931101, financed by national funds of PRR/IAPMEI.

Scientific Area: Arts (Multimedia Art and Design)

**Admission Requirements:** be enrolled in a doctorate (on the date of signing the fellowship contract or, in the case of enrolment in 2025, present a letter of commitment in which the candidate will be enrolled a doctoral program).

**Workplan:** The goal of this workplan is to foster debate on how ludic culture and digital games can be resources to promote well-being, mental health, and inclusive digital transition through podcast talks with various experts in game design, game art, game studies, gamification, AI, interaction design and gender studies. Thus, over a 10-month grant period, the doctoral student will be expected to help prepare these conversations with experts, which is intended to be an audio file and a research tool that will reflect on relevant topics addressed in the Egames lab consortium. Each episode will have an animated illustration that visually represents the topic of conversation.

We will preferably invite experts from the Interactive Technologies Institute (ITI/LARSyS) and Egames Lab partner companies.

**Workplace:** The work will be developed at the Interactive Technologies Institute of LARSyS/ IST-ID (host institution's name), under the scientific supervision of Dr. Luciana Lima and Dr. Viviane Peçaíbes.

**Duration:** The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 03 months. It's expected to begin in March 2025. The fellowship contract can be renewed up until the end of the project, up to the maximum of 48 months, including the duration of the initial contract. When the academic degree or diploma is awarded during the term of the scholarship contract, the scholarship can be completed under the contractual terms established.

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €1.259,64, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

**Selection methods**: The selection methods will be the following: *Curriculum evaluation (CE), portfolio of illustrations and/or graphic design (P), individual interview (II),* motivation letter (ML), with the respective weight of CE (3, 30%), P (3, 30%), II (2, 20%), ML (2, 20%).

**Announcement/ notification of the results**: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from February 12 until February 25, 2025.

**Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal**. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID, within 15 working days counted from the respective notification.
