Research Studentships (PhD students)

Applications are open for one (1) Research Studentship, within the framework of project/R&D institution *Pathways towards Age-friendly Neighbourhoods: Transnational research, knowledge transfer, collaborative approaches and capacity building for the transition towards the 15-minute city*, ref. DUT/0002/2023, financed by national funds through FCT, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Urbanism/Geography/Architecture/Sociology/Urban and Regional Studies

Admission Requirements:

- a) *Be enrolled in a PhD program in one of the specified scientific areas or enrolled in a non-degree course.*
- b) *Possess knowledge and experience in conducting research, data collection, and systematization within urban and social studies.*
- c) *Experience in applying participatory methodologies in urban planning.*
- d) *Organizational skills, autonomy, commitment to established objectives, and ability to work in a team.*
- e) *Proficiency in spoken and written Portuguese.*
- f) *Proficiency in spoken and written English.*

Workplan: The selected candidate will participate in the tasks of the AGE-15 project, specifically in tasks 3, 4, and 5, namely:

1. Identification and implementation of specific methodologies in the Living Lab in Lisbon.
2. Support in conducting *Walking Interviews*.
3. Support in designing the *Co-creation Workshop* in Lisbon.
4. Contribution to the dissemination and communication of results obtained from the AGE-15 approach within the case study.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2019.pdf> and <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

Workplace: The work will be carried out at Instituto Superior Técnico - CITUA, under the scientific supervision of Professor Jorge Gonçalves.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 8 months. It's expected to begin in June 2025, renewable up to the maximum of 48 months, including the duration of the initial contract.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2025/02/Tabela_valores_SMM_2025.pdf), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € €1,309.64, being the payment method of the Fellow by wire transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be as follows:

1. Curriculum evaluation (CV and qualifications) – 85%
2. Proficiency in English – 15%
3. Optional interview in case of a tie between candidates

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from March 18 until March 31, 2025.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at an academic degree course (PhD); v) motivation letter.
