

Scientific Initiation Studentships

Applications are open for 13 Scientific Initiation Studentships, within the framework of eGamesLab/IST-ID nº26, within the PRR program, financed by national funds through IAPMEI, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Engenharia Informática, Arte, Design, Multimédia e Psicologia

Admission Requirements: *To be enrolled at a professional higher technical course, at a bachelor degree, at an integrated master or master degree, or to have a bachelor degree and be enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree and it is integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units;*

Workplan: The workplan will proceed in line with the thematic published on iti.larsys.pt web page, for the 2025 Summer Scientific Initiation Studentships. Including the definition of each scientific area applied to; the art research and the prototypes/tests with users based on the published scientific areas of studies, having this research to be developed with the consortium companies of the PRR project eGamesLab.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; IST-ID Regulation of Scientific Research Fellowships, available on <https://ist-id.pt/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#documentos-relacionados>.

Workplace: It will be developed at Interactive Technologies Institute of IST.ID, under supervision of Professors Nuno Jardim Nunes, Hugo Nicolau, Élvio Gouveia, Daniel Simões Lopes, Lucas Pereira, José Luís Silva, Luciana Lima e Mara Dionísio.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 3 months. It's expected to begin in June 2025, and it will not be renewable.

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €651,12, being the payment method of the Fellow by wire transfer.

Selection methods: Curriculum Vitae detailing the main academic achievements (if applicable), skills, competencies, technical expertise, and relevant experience in the fields of Computer Engineering, Art, Design, Multimedia, Psychology, or closely related areas. The jury may choose to conduct an individual interview to clarify aspects related to the application, which may serve as an exclusion criterion.

Composition of the selection Jury: Prof. Daniel Simões Lopes, Prof. Hugo Nicolau & Prof. Nuno Nunes.

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal: a complaint may be lodged from the final decision, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID, within 15 working days counted from the respective notification.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from April 14 until April 29, 2025.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at an academic degree course or at a course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter;
