Post-Doctoral Research Fellowships

Applications are open for 1 (one) Post-Doctoral Research Fellowship(s), within the framework of project eGameslab n26 of IST-ID, funded by the PRR/IAPMEI.

Scientific Area: Computer and Information Sciences and Informatics

Admission Requirements:

- a) to hold a PhD degree obtained in the 3 years previously to the beginning of the fellowship contract;
- b) to have carried out the research work that led to the PhD degree in a different entity from the host institution of the fellowship;
- c) Not to exceed, with this fellowship contract, including the possible renovations, an accumulated period of 3 years in this type of fellowship, continuously or with interruptions;
- d) Not to have previously held a post-doctoral fellowship from IST-ID.

Workplan: (i) conducting interviews with artists and creative technologists to gather insights on processes involving AI-driven storytelling, artistic practices, technology development, and interactive design; (ii) analyze the role of AI and interactivity in contemporary storytelling practices, drawing from fields such as artistic studies, the philosophy of technology, and digital media theory. (iii) research-led discussion events to promote interdisciplinary dialogue around embodiment, storytelling, and technology in artistic, technological, and interactive digital environments; and (iv) assisting writing and dissemination activities (e.g., writing scientific articles, public presentations).

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; IST-ID Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on <https://ist-id.pt/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#documentos-relacionados> .

Workplace: The work will be developed at the Instituto de Tecnologias Interactivas / LARSyS, under the scientific supervision of Professor Daniel Simões Lopes and Professor Diogo Cabral.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 09 months. It's expected to begin in June 2025 and may be eventually renewed up to end of the project egamesLab, with the limit of 36 months, including the duration of the initial contract.

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 1851.00, being the payment method of the Fellow by wire transfer.

Selection methods: Curriculum vitae detailing the main academic results (conference presentations, participation in research and artistic projects), critical and theoretical skills (storytelling, digital media theory), experience in organizing academic/artistic events (e.g., seminars, performances, workshops), experience in research projects that combine art and technology, and relevant experience in areas such as Philosophy of Science, Technology, Art, Multimedia or a closely related area (75%), individual interview (25%).

Composition of the selection Jury: Prof. Daniel Simões Lopes; Prof. Diogo Cabral; Prof. Augusto Esteves.

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID, within 15 working days counted from the respective notification.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from May 6 until May 19, 2025.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate; iv) motivation letter; v) declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract an accumulated

period of three years in this type of fellowship, continuously or with interruptions, within the technological and scientific system, and that the research work that led to the PhD degree was carried out in a different entity from the host institution of the fellowship.
