Admission Requirements: To be enrolled in the Master's Degree in Transportation Systems or related Master's degree.

Workplan: The selected grantee will join the Streets 4 All project team and will work predominantly in the final phase of the research (last six months of project development), contributing to the scientific dissemination of the results and organizing the international closing event.

The tasks to be developed will include:

• Systematize and disseminate the scientific results of the project, preparing technical reports and executive summaries;

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: i) Curriculum Vitae evaluation (CV); ii) training and experience in the field of transportation systems (especially in urban mobility and public transportation) (EXP); iii) individual interview (INT), with the respective weight of (i) CV - 50%, (ii) EXP - 25%; (iii) INT - 25%, in the final grade (FG). During the interview, a candidate will be excluded if they do not prove their English proficiency.

The Final Grade (FG) is calculated with the following equation: FG = 50% x CV + 25% x EXP + 25% x INT.
