Research Scholarship for a student enrolled in a course not leading to an academic degree or a PhD student

Applications are open for one (1) Research Scholarship for a student enrolled in a course not leading to an academic degree or a PhD student, within the framework of the project "Novel eco-cementitious materials and components for durable, competitive, and bio-inspired offshore floating PV substructures (NaturSea-PV)" of the Association of Instituto Superior Técnico for Research and Development (IST-ID), reference *GA n.º 101084348*, financed by the "Horizon-Widera-2022-Access-07-01" programme, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering

Admission Requirements: Masters in Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering, or similar areas and to be enrolled a PhD or to be enrolled in a course not leading to an academic degree

Workplan: The candidate to be selected is expected to support and work on research activities in the area of "Offshore Renewable Energy".

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; IST-ID Regulation of Scientific Research Fellowships, available on https://ist-id.pt/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#documentos-relacionados.

Workplace: The work will be developed at the Centre for Marine Technology and Ocean Engineering of Instituto Superior Técnico, Universidade de Lisboa, under the scientific supervision of Prof. Carlos Guedes Soares.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 12 months. It's expected to begin on 1st October 2025, and may be renewed for PhD student, up to the maximum of 48 months, including the duration of the initial contract.

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €1.309,64, being the payment method of the Fellow by wire transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: *Curriculum evaluation, individual interview (optional)*, with the respective weight of *Curriculum evaluation* (30%), *individual interview (optional)* (70%).

Composition of the selection Jury: Prof. Ângelo Teixeira (President of the Jury); Prof. Tiago A. Santos (Member); Prof. Shan Wang (Member).

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID, within 15 working days counted from the respective notification.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from July 21 until July 25, 2025.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/); ii) Curriculum Vitae; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at an academic degree course or at a course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter;
