Scientific Area: Sciences of Chemical Engineering, and related areas

Admission Requirements: To be enrolled at a PhD.

Workplan: Development of applications for depolymerized lignin and resulting copolymers. Synthesis and characterization of porous microspheres. Communication and dissemination of results.

Workplace: The work will be developed at Centro de Recursos Naturais e Ambiente (CERENA) of Instituto Superior Técnico, under the scientific supervision of Prof. Ana Clara Marques.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 12 months. It's expected to begin in November, 2025, and may be eventually renewed up to the maximum of 36 months, including the duration of the initial contract.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/fct-atualizou-o-valor-das-bolsas-para-2025/), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 1309,64, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: *Curriculum evaluation* (40%) and relevant experience for the project, namely lignin depolymerization, radical polymerization and synthesis of porous materials by sol-gel (60%). An interview may be conducted if appropriate, to help with the decision.
