1 Research Studentship for students of a course that does not award an academic degree

Applications are open for one Research Studentship for students of a course that does not award an academic degree, within the framework of project 1801P.01516 – OptSurgAl 2024.07248.IACDC) apoiado pela medida "RE-CO5-i08.M04 – "Apoiar o lançamento de um programa de projetos de I&D orientado para o desenvolvimento e implementação de sistemas avançados de cibersegurança, inteligência artificial e ciência de dados na administração pública, bem como de um programa de capacitação científica", do Plano de Recuperação e Resiliência – PRR, enquadrado no contrato de financiamento celebrado entre a Estrutura de Missão Recuperar Portugal (EMRP) e a Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia I.P. Scientific Area: Artificial Intelligence.

Admission Requirements:

- a) to hold a BSc or MSc degree, at the time of contract signature;
- b) to be enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree and it is integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units, at the time of contract signature;
- c) not to exceed with this contract, including the possible renovations, an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.

Workplan: To develop deep learning approaches for segmentation and classification of surgical videos.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968.

Workplace: The work will be developed at Instituto de Sistemas e Robótica, from Instituto Superior Técnico, under the scientific supervision of Professor Catarina Barata.

Duration: The research fellowships will have the duration of 6 months. It's expected to begin in January 2026, and may be eventually renewed up to the end of the project, with the limit of 12 months, including the duration of the initial contract.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/fct-atualizou-o-valor-das-bolsas-para-2025/), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €1040,98 for bachelor degree and € 1309,64 for master degree, being the payment method by Wire Transfer.

Selection methods: Curriculum evaluation (80%) and previous experience on the topics related to the grant (20%). The candidates may be invited for an interview, for additional discrimination between levels of expertise.

Composition of the selection Jury: Catarina Barata, Carlos Santiago, and Plinio Moreno.

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal: A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from December 2 until December 16, 2025.
