

Research Studentships (for students of a course that does not award an academic degree)

Applications are open for 1 (one) Course that does not award an academic degree Research Studentship(s), within the framework of the project eGamesLab n26 CC931101, financed by IAPMEI.

Scientific Area: Computer and Information Sciences and Informatics

Admission Requirements: *to hold a bachelor or master degree and be enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree and it is integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units;*

Workplan: The selected candidates will participate in research activities that include: (i) use LLMs to convert text into visual representations of data, (ii) design and implement AR and VR interfaces that rely on pen input, (iii) prepare materials for VR and AR tutorials (WebXR and Lens Studio), and (iv) assisting all writing and dissemination activities (e.g., user manuals, writing scientific articles, public presentations).

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; IST-ID Regulation of Scientific Research Fellowships, available on <https://ist-id.pt/recursos/documentos/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#1690453819726-6707f7f2-ce04>

Workplace: The work will be developed at ITI of IST, under the scientific supervision of Prof. Daniel Simões Lopes

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 4 months; it is expected to begin in March of 2026 and may be eventually renewed up to the end of the project.

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is 1309,64€, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: educational degree and work experience 75%; and interview 25%.

Composition of the selection Jury: Prof. Pedro Campos, Prof. Diogo Cabral, Prof. Daniel Simões Lopes

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. After notification of the provisional list of evaluation results, candidates have a period of 10 working days to, if they wish, make a statement at a preliminary hearing of interested parties, in accordance with Articles 121 et seq. of the Code of Administrative Procedure. The final decision will be made after analyzing the statements presented at the preliminary hearing of interested parties. The final decision may be appealed to the competition jury or to the President of IST-ID within 15 working days of notification

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from February 16 until March 2, 2026.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#documentos-relacionados>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter; vi) declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.
