Research Studentships (for Master students)

Applications are open for 1 Research Studentship, within the framework of project **1801P.01158.1.04 LA/P/0083/2020 - ISR - SIPG LAB/ISR** and **1801P.01460.1.02 LARSYS/ISR BASE 2025-2029 - DSOR LAB/ISR** financed by national funds FCT/MCTES, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Aerospace, Computer Science, Mechanical Engineering and similar areas

Admission Requirements: *To be enrolled at an integrated master or a master.*

Workplan: Develop and implement algorithms to calibrate network of RGB cameras.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

Workplace: The work will be developed at Instituto de Sistemas e Robótica of Instituto Superior Técnico, under the scientific supervision of Doctor Manuel Marques and co-supervision of Professor João Paulo Costeira.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 3 months. It's expected to begin in June 2026 and may be eventually renewed.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (<https://www.fct.pt/fct-atualizou-o-valor-das-bolsas-para-2026/>), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 1090,98€, being the payment method by Wire Transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: i) Curriculum evaluation and ii) Programming skills with a respective weight of 60%/40%. There may be a possible individual interview, eliminatory in nature, to be used only if the previous selection method is not enough for a decision.

Composition of the selection Jury: Professor João Paulo Costeira, João Pedro Gomes and Doctor Manuel Marques

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from May 25 until June 8, 2026.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents:

i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#documentos-relacionados>);

ii) *Curriculum Vitae*;

iii) Proof of enrollment at an academic degree course (Master, Integrated Master);

v) declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.
