Research Studentships (PhD students)

Applications are open for one (1) Research Studentship, within the framework of project/R&D Growth or SPINE 1801P.01248.1 | CERIS, financed by european funds (H2020), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Systems, Urbanism, Transportation and Environment

Admission Requirements: *To be enrolled at a PhD.*

Workplan: Develop and carry out research tasks focused on the main topics of the project, related to:

- Interaction with the project's stakeholders;
- Helping to coordinate the data collection tasks necessary for the development of the project, namely the design, preparation and implementation of surveys;
- Develop quantitative research on residential and user satisfaction;
- Carry out collaborative research with other members of the project team;
- Preparing scientific publications and presentations;
- Contribute to project management activities under the supervision of the Principal Investigator

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; IST-ID Regulation of Scientific Research Fellowships, available on <https://ist-id.pt/recursos/documentos/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#1690453819726-6707f7f2-ce04>.

Workplace: The work will be developed at CERIS of Associação do Instituto Superior Técnico para a Investigação e o Desenvolvimento (IST-ID), under the scientific supervision of Prof. João de Abreu e Silva.

Duration: The research fellowship will have the duration of 7 months. It's expected to begin in September/2026, and may be eventually renewed until the end of the project

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 1450,00€, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following:

Curriculum evaluation where the candidate should demonstrate experience in research. Evidence of published research in the scientific areas of the call and/or the project will be considered also. The candidates selected for the interview will be the ones with the highest score in the curricular evaluation, with the respective weight of 70% curricular evaluation and 30% interview

Composition of the selection Jury: Prof. João de Abreu e Silva, Prof. Paulo Teixeira, Prof^a Ana Paula Falcão

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. After notification of the provisional list of evaluation results, candidates have a period of 10 working days to, if they wish, make a statement at a preliminary hearing of interested parties, in accordance with Articles 121 et seq. of the Code of Administrative Procedure. The final decision will be made after analyzing the statements presented at the preliminary hearing of interested parties. The final decision may be appealed to the competition jury or to the President of IST-ID within 15 working days of notification

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from August 19 until August 25, 2026.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/recursos-humanos/bolseiros/#documentos-relacionados>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at an academic degree course (PhD); v) motivation letter.
