Research Studentships for Master or Integrated Master students

Applications are open for 1 Research Studentship, within the scope of the R&D Unit CiTUA - Centre for Innovation in Territory, Urbanism and Architecture, ref. UIDP/05703/2020, with the financial support of FCT/MCTES through national funds, under the following conditions.

Scientific Area: Architecture, Territory, Urban Planning, Environmental Engineering, Geography

Admission Requirements: Have a final degree classification equal to or higher than 17 points. Be enrolled on a master's degree or integrated master's degree. Proficiency in computer programmes for word processing (such as MS Word) and data processing (PostgreSQL, Python). Proficiency in Portuguese and English (spoken and written, advanced - preferred). The candidate must also have proven experience of working with national UI&D and with actors at municipal level, such as town halls, and experience of organising events.

Workplan: As part of CiTUA, the candidate's duties will include: 1) supporting the scientific management and operationalisation of the centre's activities namely foreseen events; 2) contributing to the maintenance of the databases that support the centre's progress indicators; and 3) collaborating, together with other members of the team, in the preparation of reports and contributing to CiTUA's activity plans.

Workplace: The work will be developed at CiTUA - Centre for Innovation in Territory, Urbanism and Architecture, under the scientific supervision of Doctor Rute Martins.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 3 months. It's expected to begin in February 2024, and may be eventually renewed up to the end of the project.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_2023.pdf), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €930,98, being the payment method by Wire Transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following:

- 1. Curriculum evaluation (80%);
- 2. Experience in research (20%);
- 3. Individual interview (optional in case of a tie).

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from January 24 until February 6, 2024.
