

Research Studentships (for students of a course that does not award an academic degree)

Applications are open for 1 Research Studentship, within the scope of the R&D Unit CiTUA - Centre for Innovation in Territory, Urbanism and Architecture, ref. UIDP/05703/2020, with the financial support of FCT/MCTES (PIDDAC), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Architecture/ Urban and Regional Systems/ Geography

Admission Requirements: The scholarship is intended for students enrolled in non-degree courses (at the date of submission). The candidate must have: Knowledge of computer programs for text processing (as MS Word), data processing (like MS Excel); Basic knowledge of Geographical Information Systems; Domain of Portuguese language (advanced spoken and written, preferential factor), English (spoken and written, preferential factor).

Workplan: The Território.justo.pt project, integrated in the Spatial Justice Lab of CiTUA, intends to be an exercise in the production of transdisciplinary knowledge that applies the concept of spatial justice in its complexity to the reality of Portugal, on a municipal basis. The project's tasks, which are part of this Scholarship, go through five phases: Learn - Literature Review and selection and analysis of case studies; Build - Proposition of a model/index of Spatial Justice, to be applied to all municipalities in Portugal; Apply - Application of the model in all municipalities on the continent; Simulate - Simulation of scenarios for a municipality based on the manipulation of the data obtained; and Communicate - Scientific dissemination and public dissemination of the intermediate and final results of the project.

It is specifically intended to carry out the following functions: (a) Research and review of reference scientific literature; (b) Specific bibliographical research - political, technical and statistical - and collection and spatialization of relevant data (census and others); (c) Fieldwork and exploratory visits to territories, archives, or other institutions relevant to the project; (d) General support for the execution of the project through the preparation of reports, various contacts and collaboration in other forms of dissemination; (e) Collaboration in scientific publications (articles, chapters and book) and in other activities to disseminate results (project website, Summer School, Workshop, Podcast).

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2019.pdf> and <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

Workplace: The work will be developed at CiTUA - Centre for Innovation in Territory, Urbanism and Architecture, under the scientific supervision of Professor Jorge Gonçalves.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 6 months. It's expected to begin in June 2023, and may be eventually renewed up to the end of the project.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €930,98, being the payment method by Wire Transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following:

1. Curriculum evaluation (80%).
2. Experience in research (20%).
3. Individual interview (optional in case of a tie).

Composition of the selection Jury: Prof. Jorge Gonçalves, Dr. Rute Martins, Dr. Silvia Jorge.

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from May 22 until June 2, 2023.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at a course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter; vi) declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.
