## Scientific Initiation Studentships

Applications are open for 4 Scientific Initiation Studentships, within the framework of eGamesLab/IST-ID nº26, within the PRR program, financed by national funds through IAPMEI, under the following conditions:

**Scientific Area:** Engenharia Informática, Arte, Design, Multimédia e Psicologia

### Admission Requirements:

- a) *To be enrolled at a professional higher technical course, at a bachelor degree, at an integrated master or master degree, or to have a bachelor degree and be enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree and it is integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units;*
- b) *not to exceed with this contract, including the possible renovations, an accumulated period of one year in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions;*
- c) *not to have held any other fellowship directly or indirectly funded by FCT.*

**Workplan:** The workplan will proceed in line with the thematic published on [iti.larsys.pt](http://iti.larsys.pt) web page, for the 2024 Summer Scientific Initiation Studentships. Including the definition of each scientific area applied to; the art research and the prototypes/tests with users based on the published scientific areas of studies, especially in AI, VR, Games for the Green Deal & Storytelling, having this research to be developed with the consortium companies of the PRR project eGamesLab.

**Legislation and Regulations:** Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2019.pdf> and <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

**Workplace:** It will be developed at Interactive Technologies Institute of IST.ID, under supervision of Professores Doutores Nuno Jardim Nunes, Valentina Nisi, Hugo Nicolau, Augusto Esteves, Daniel Lopes, Filipa Correia e Lucas Pereira.

**Duration:** The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 3 months. It's expected to begin in July 2024, and it will not be renewable.

**Monthly maintenance allowance:** According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal ([https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM\\_atualizacao-2024.pdf](https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_atualizacao-2024.pdf)), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €601,12, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

**Selection methods:** The selection methods will be: Curricular evaluation (AC), recommendations letters (CR), interview (EI): AC (5, 50%), CR (2, 20%) and EI (3, 30%)

**Composition of the selection Jury:** Prof. Nuno Nunes; Prof. Valentina Nisi; Prof. Hugo Nicolau

**Announcement/ notification of the results:** The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

**Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal.** A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

**Application deadline and formalization:** The call is open from June 20 until July 3, 2024.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, where

applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at an academic degree course or at a course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter; vi) declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract, including the possible renovations, an accumulated period of one year in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions, and has not held any other fellowship directly or indirectly funded by FCT.
