Research Studentships for PhD students

Applications are open for 1 Research Studentship, within the scope of the R&D Unit CiTUA - Centre for Innovation in Territory, Urbanism and Architecture, ref. UIDP/05703/2020, with the financial support of FCT/MCTES through national funds, under the following conditions.

Scientific Area: Design

Admission Requirements:

- a) To be enrolled at a PhD.
- b) Proficiency in Portuguese (spoken and written, advanced - elimination factor) and English (spoken and written - elimination factor).

Workplan:

1. Participate in drawing up CiTUA's communication strategy
2. Producing and editing multimedia content
3. Streamlining CiTUA's communication channels: website and social networks
4. Collaborate in publicising CiTUA's scientific areas
5. Supporting events: programming, scheduling, organisation and dissemination
6. Interface with the Instituto Superior Técnico's communications office

Workplace: The work will be developed at CiTUA - Centre for Innovation in Territory, Urbanism and Architecture, under the scientific supervision of Doctor Rute Martins.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 4 months. It's expected to begin in September 2024, and may be eventually renewed up to the end of the project, with the limit of 48 months, including the duration of the initial contract.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_atualizacao-2024.pdf), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is 1.259,64€, being the payment method by Wire Transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following:

1. Curriculum evaluation (80%)
2. Experience in research (20%)
3. Individual interview (optional in case of a tie)

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from July 31 until August 13, 2024.
