## Scientific Initiation Studentships

Applications are open for 1 Scientific Initiation Studentships, within the framework of project eGameLab n26 CC931101, financed by national funds through PRR (Plano de Recuperação e Resiliência, through IAPMEI – Agência para a Competitividade e Inovação):

**Scientific Area:** Psychology

**Admission Requirements:** *To be enrolled at a professional higher technical course, at a bachelor degree, at an integrated master or master degree, or to have a bachelor degree and be enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree and it is integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units;*

**Workplan:** The work plan will be in HCI, in order to support the research within nature and cultural patrimony. Handle different tools to conduct studies in real scenarios, as for example in public spaces e and other important surroundings. To collect and analyse relevant data, as well as preparing the results for presentations and scientific publications.

**Legislation and Regulations:** Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

**Workplace:** The work will be developed at Interactive Technologies Institute from IST-ID, under the supervision of prof. Valentina Nisi.

**Duration:** The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 3 months *not renewable*. It's expected to begin in October 2024.

**Monthly maintenance allowance:** the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 601,12, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

**Selection methods:** The selection methods will be: Curricular evaluation (AC), recommendations letters (CR), interview (EI): AC (5, 50%), CR (2, 20%) and EI (3, 30%)

**Composition of the selection Jury:** Hugo Nicolau (Associate Professor, IST); Nuno Nunes (Full Professor, IST); Valentina Nisi (Full Professor, IST).

**Announcement/ notification of the results:** The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

**Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal.** A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

**Application deadline and formalization:** The call is open from September 30 until October 11, 2024.
