

Research Studentships (for students of a course that does not award an academic degree)

Applications are open for two Research Studentship(s), within the framework of project/R&D institution (1801P.01074.1.01) FuturePharma, (PTDC/EME-SIS/6019/2020), financed by national funds through FCT/MCTES (PIDDAC), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Systems Engineering and Management

Admission Requirements:

a) to hold a bachelor or master degree and be enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree and it is integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units;

b) not to exceed with this contract, including the possible renovations, an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.

Workplan: The main objective of this project is to develop models with practical use for boosting the integration of complex decisions that occur at different levels of the pharmaceutical supply chains. This research project focuses on the development of models considering features that have received little attention, such as sustainability issues, the complexity and uncertain operating in a highly regulated sector, and new technological innovations that will impact the supply chain.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2019.pdf> and <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

Workplace: The work will be developed at Centro de Estudos de Gestão do Instituto Superior Técnico (CEG-IST) from IST-ID, under the scientific supervision of Professor Tânia Pinto Varela and Prof. Ana Paula Brabosa Póvoa.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 6 months. It's expected to begin in October/2023, and may be eventually renewed up to the project's terminus.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_2023.pdf), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is 1199.64€, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: curriculum evaluation (accompanied by an interview, if the jury deems it necessary) and motivation letter, with valuation weights respectively of 90% (curricular evaluation and interview, if the jury deems it necessary) and 10% (letter of interest).

Composition of the selection Jury: President: Professor Tânia Pinto Varela. Members: Professor Ana Póvoa and Professor Tânia Ramos.

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from September 13 until September 26, 2023.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>); ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, or proof of

completion of the master's degrees, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at a course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter; vi) declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.
