Post-Doctoral Research Fellowships

Applications are open for 1 Post-Doctoral Research Fellowship, within the framework of project/R&D institution LoGaCulture — Locative Games for Cultural Heritage (Grant Agreement 101094036), financed by the European Commission funds through the European Research Executive Agency (REA/C/01), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Arts – Design and Organizations (research through design, urban and organization studies)

Admission Requirements:

- a) *to hold a PhD degree obtained in the 3 years previously to the submission of the fellowship application;*
- b) *to have carried out the research work that led to the PhD degree in a different entity from the host institution of the fellowship;*
- c) *Not to exceed, with this fellowship contract, including the possible renovations, an accumulated period of 3 years in this type of fellowship, continuously or with interruptions;*
- d) *Not to have previously held a post-doctoral fellowship from IST-ID.*

Workplan:

- 1) Initial research on the current state of the art of locative media for nature as culture in the context of the LogaCulture EU Project;
- 2) Literature review publication, support in the design and development of LogaCulture pilot in Madeira Island;
- 3) Preparation of journal papers for A/A* conference and Q1 journals on the project results.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, available on <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2019.pdf> and <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

Workplace: The work will be developed at ITI /LARSyS of IST under the scientific supervision of Professor Valentina Nisi.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 12 months. It's expected to begin in October 2023 and may be eventually renewed up to the maximum of 36 months.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is €1741, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check. To this amount there will an extra monthly payment of €142,21 destined to pay the Social Security and €20,48/year for personal insurance costs.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (CE), Recommendation letters (RL) and Virtual Individual Interview (VII) with the respective weight of AC (5,50%), RL (2,20%) and VII (3,30%).
