Scientific Initiation Studentships

Applications are open for 1 Scientific Initiation Studentships, within the framework of Green multi-action products for the sustainable conservation of historic porous building stones/ Centro de Química Estrutural, Associação do Instituto Superior Técnico para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento (IST-ID) (PTDC/ECI-EGC/2519/2020) with the financial support of FCT/MCTES through national funds and under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Civil Engineering - Construction

Admission Requirements:

- a) To be enrolled at a professional higher technical course, at a bachelor degree, at an integrated master or master degree, or to have a bachelor degree and be enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree and it is integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units;
- b) not to exceed with this contract, including the possible renovations, an accumulated period of one year in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions;
- c) not to have held any other fellowship directly or indirectly funded by FCT.

Workplan: The applicant's objective is to: i) characterize stone objects from historical built heritage made of Ançã Stone and Grés de Silves; ii) Treat the stone objects with multi-action products developed and prepared by the other Team members and characterize the treatments; iii) study the efficacy (consolidation and protection against water-related phenomena) and compatibility of the treatments (e.g. color alterations).

Workplace: The work will be developed at *Centro de Química Estrutural (CQE), Instituto de Investigação e Inovação em Engenharia Civil para a Sustentabilidade (CERIS)* from *Associação do Instituto Superior Técnico para a Investigação e Desenvolvimento (IST-ID)*, under the scientific supervision of Doctor Bruno Sena da Fonseca and Prof. Ana Paula Ferreira Pinto.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 6 months (not renewable). It's expected to begin in December 2024.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM atualizacao-2024.pdf), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 601,12, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: i) number of curricular units concluded on the scientific area of the studentship (construction) (curricular units/points: 0/0; 1/10; 2 or 3/15 and 4 or more/20); ii) average of their classification; iii) motivation letter. The respective weights are 40%, 40% and 30%.

Composition of the selection Jury: Doctor Bruno Sena da Fonseca, Prof. Marta Alves and Prof. Ana Paula Ferreira Pinto.



Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from October 28 until November 11, 2024.
