1 Research Studentship for students of a course that does not award an academic degree

Applications are open for 1 Research Studentship for students of a course that does not award an academic degree, within the framework of project Responsible.AI (Contrato nº 12 - IST-ID) financed by national funds PRR (Plano de Recuperação e Resiliência), through IAPMEI - Agência para a Competitividade e Inovação, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Bioengineering, Biotechnology, and Biochemistry.

Admission Requirements: to hold an MSc degree and to be enrolled a course that does not award an academic degree

Workplan: The scholarship holder will collect and analyse electroencephalography (EEG) data.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; IST-ID Regulation https://ist-id.pt/files/sites/43/regulamento-de-bolsas-da-ist_id-2.pdf

Workplace: The work will be developed at Institute of Systems and Robotics of Instituto Superior Técnico, under the scientific co-supervision of Professor Patrícia Figueiredo and Dr. Julia Erb.

Duration: The research fellowship will have a duration of 6 months. It is expected to begin in January 2025 and may be renewed for 6 months (up to a total of 12 months).

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 1 259,64, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: 1) relevance of academic degree and respective grade (25%); 2) experience in analysis of electroencephalography data and auditory stimulus processing (25%); 3) motivation letter (25%); e 4) global evaluation by the jury (25%). The jury will interview up to a maximum of three candidates with the highest marks. In order to make a more objective assessment of some of these criteria, the interview* will count 50% towards each of the above criteria.

Composition of the selection Jury: Professors Patrícia Figueiredo, Professor Rita Nunes and Doctor Julia Erb

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal: a complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from December 2 until December 13, 2024.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents:

- i) B1 Form – Fellowship application (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>);
- ii) Curriculum Vitae;
- iii) official academic MSc degree certificate;
- iv) motivation letter.
- v) Proof of enrollment at a course that does not award an academic degree (only after the selection of the candidates and for signing the grant contract);
- vi) Declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.
