

NOTICE FOR THE ATTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIPS IN THE CONTEXT OF R&D PROJECTS AND INSTITUTIONS

Research Scholarship (student of a course that does not grant an academic degree)

A call is open for the attribution of 1 Research Scholarship(s) within the scope of the R&D project/institution CEG-IST Project | Professor Ana Carvalho - IST-ID (1801P.00971.1.01), UIDB/00097/2020, financed by national funds through FCT/MCTES (PIDDAC), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Systems Engineering and Management

Admission requirements:

a) *have a degree and be enrolled in a course that does not confer an academic degree (at the date of signature of the contract) as part of the educational project of a higher education institution, developed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units;*

b) *not to exceed, with the conclusion of the scholarship contract in question, including possible renewals, an accumulated period of two years in this type of scholarship, consecutive or interpolated.*

c) *Experience in the area of human and social sciences, with an emphasis on issues of ethics, mediation of conflicts and preferably with experience in field work and conducting surveys.*

Work plan: 1) Literature review in the area of social sustainability in the supply chain; 2) Identification of social indicators, more specifically on issues of ethics and mediation of conflicts between different stakeholders in the supply chain; 3) Assessment of the social impact of sustainability actions on companies in the supply chain.

Applicable legislation and regulations: Law No. 40/2004, of August 18 (Statute of the Scientific Research Fellow), as amended by Decree-Law No. 123/2019, of August 28; Regulation of FCT Research Grants, available at <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2019.pdf> <https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968>.

Workplace: The work will be developed at the CEG-IST of Instituto Superior Técnico, under the scientific guidance of Professor Ana Isabel Cerqueira de Sousa Gouveia Carvalho.

Duration of the) Scholarship(s): The scholarship will have a duration of 9 months, starting in July 2021. The scholarship contract may be renewed for a maximum of 12 months.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to € 835.98, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in the Country (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), being the method of payment of the Scholarship holder option by Bank Transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be the following: *curriculum evaluation, individual interview*, with the respective valuation of 70% *curriculum evaluation* and 30% *individual interview*.

Notification of results: All candidates will be notified by email of the Final Evaluation Results.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST-ID within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

Application deadline and form of submission of applications: The call is open in the period of 22 June until 5 July 2021.

Applications must be formalized by sending the following documents: i) Form B1 – Application for a Research Scholarship (<https://ist-id.pt/concursos/bolsas/>), ii) Curriculum Vitae; iii) Certificate of qualifications, if applicable; iv) Proof of enrollment in a non-degree course; v) Declaration on honor that it does not exceed, with the conclusion of the scholarship contract in question, an accumulated period of two years in this type of scholarship, consecutive or interpolated.
